



VOLUNTEER TUTOR

Are you from a farming background with a good knowledge of how mathematical concepts are applied in a farming context? Or maybe you're a maths teacher who is keen to share your knowledge of how maths is used in everyday life? We are looking for someone to volunteer with us as a tutor assisting one of our residents with range of mathematical skills as they work toward their goal of working in a rural setting.

ABOUT FOYER OXFORD

Foyer Oxford is an accommodation service for young people aged 16-25 based in the centre of Leederville. Foyer Oxford combines holistic support, high quality housing and access to flexible training, to give young people the opportunity to thrive long term. Run by a consortium of Anglicare WA, Foundation housing and the North Metropolitan TAFE, Foyer Oxford is an innovative solution that inspires young people to follow their strengths and aspirations on a journey into work and out of homelessness.

ABOUT THE ROLE

One of our residents has a long-term goal of working on a farm and is seeking study support in maths. They are particularly interested in building their skills in the following: calculating volume and area, measurement and weight conversion, and addition and subtraction across different units (ie: money, kilograms/grams, litres, date and time measurement.) It would be ideal if the volunteer we choose to engage is comfortable engaging with these concepts as they would occur in real life situations, and even better, in farming environments. This may be through working through skills in a practical way, to complement book-based exercises, or through other online methods.

First and foremost however, it is really important that the volunteer we engage for this role is reliable, comfortable explaining the mathematical concepts, enjoys working with young people, and is confident, flexible and friendly! By volunteering one or two hours of your time per week, you will play a significant role in helping one of our young residents achieve their career goals.

TIMING / REQUIREMENTS

We are looking for someone who is able to volunteer 1-2hours on a weekly basis, at Foyer Oxford. Timing is flexible as you will select a mutually agreeable time with the resident, but will likely be Tuesday nights.

All volunteers at Foyer Oxford are required by law to hold or successfully apply for both a Volunteer National Police Certificate and Working with Children Check before commencing as a volunteer. (Foyer Oxford will assist with this process for volunteers who do not already have these clearances). In addition, all volunteers will also need to successfully complete Foyer Oxford's induction and screening processes. Please note, we only have a limited number of positions at any one time at Foyer Oxford, and is important that our volunteers are a good fit for our community, particularly for roles where volunteers and residents work one-to-one. As such, we ask that volunteers understand that the induction process can be time-consuming and that not all volunteers will necessarily be successful in being placed in the role for which they apply.
